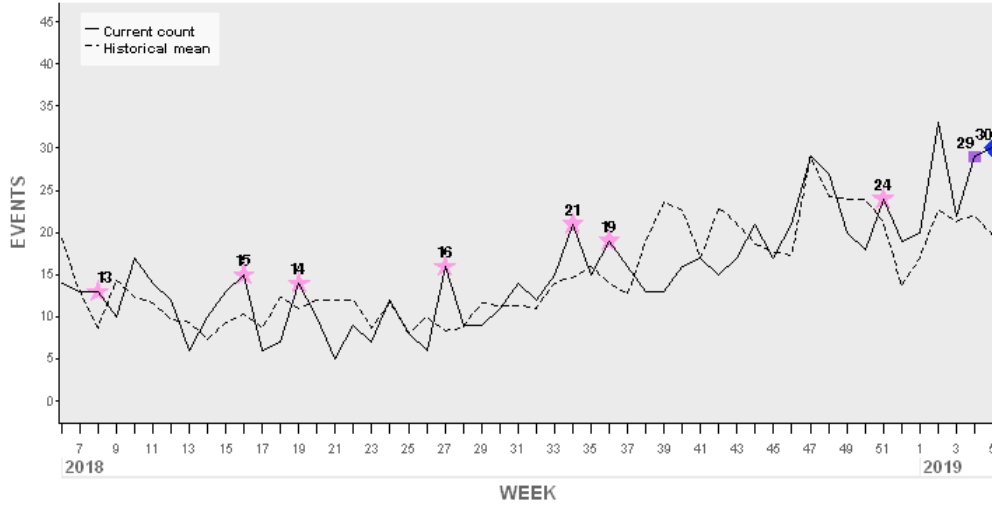

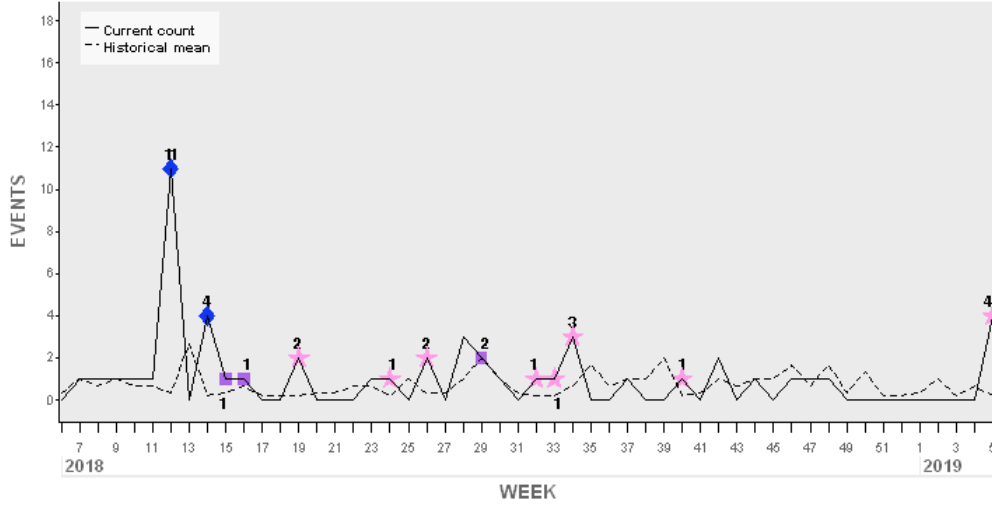

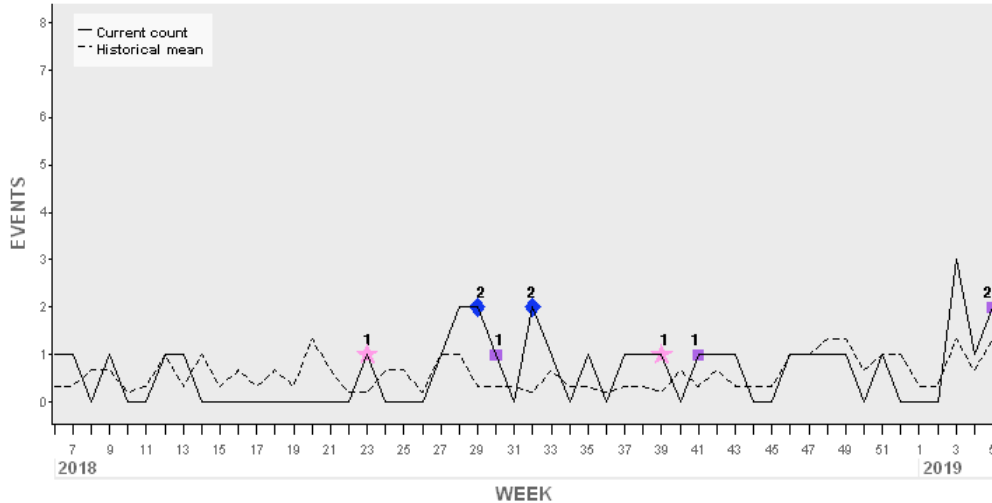
Gastroenteritis

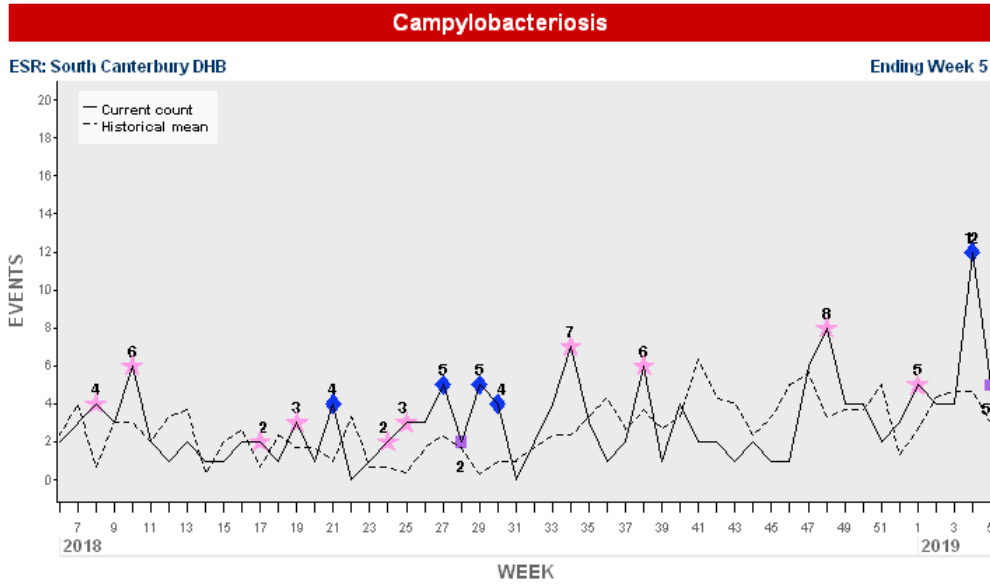


Tuberculosis disease
