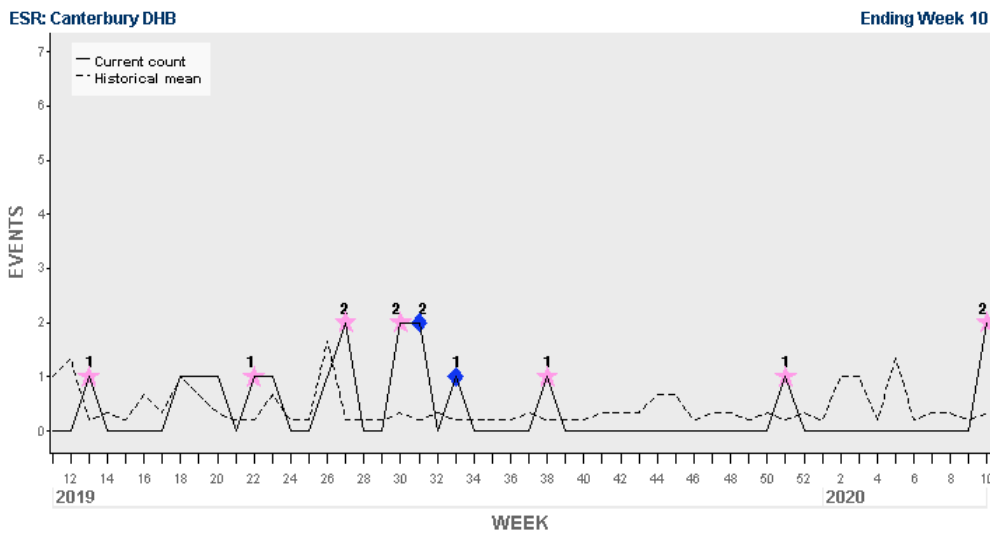

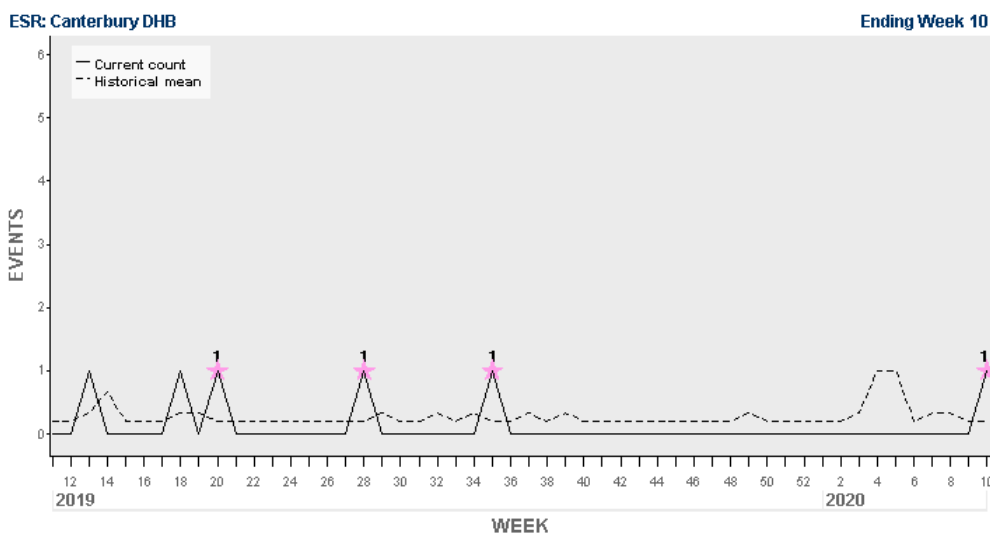

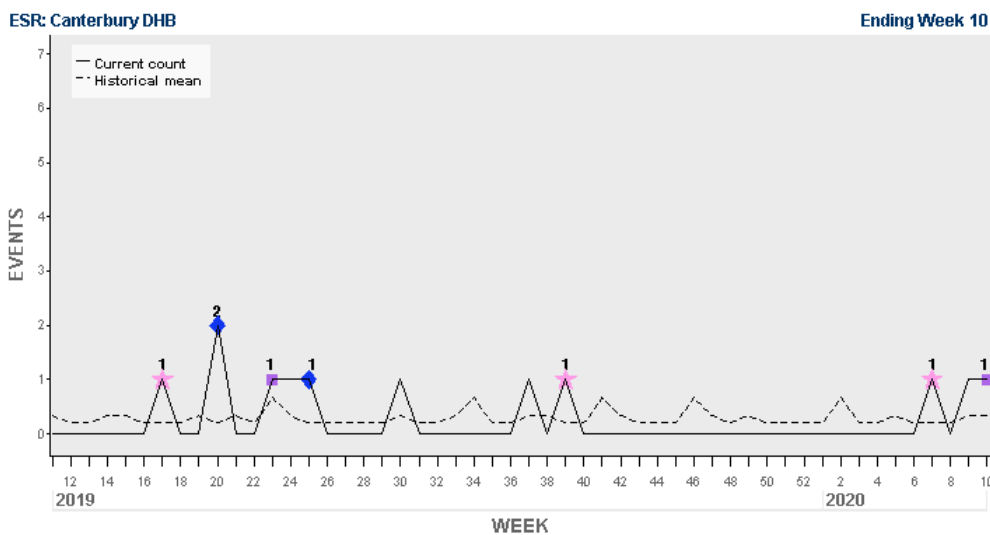
Dengue fever



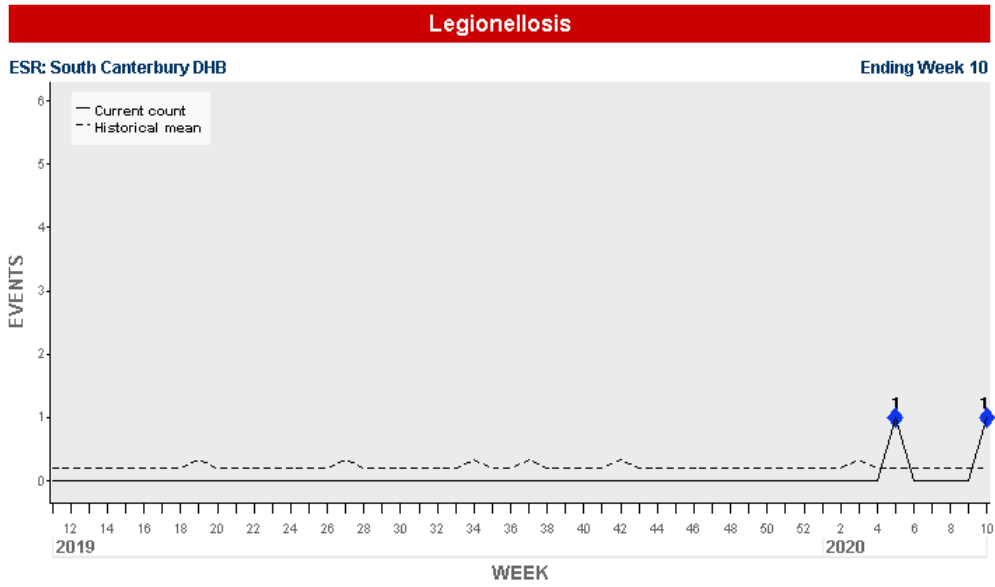
Hepatitis C
